Terms and Conditions	
Amount	Scholarships are limited in number, and subject to availability of funds. Even if an applicant meets all the scholarship criteria, a scholarship may not be awarded. For 2024: The maximum amount available per successful applicant is \$5,000. Amounts awarded to individual recipients may vary at the discretion of the Trustees. Applicants may apply for less than the maximum amount available.
Timing	If the Trustees declare funds are available for distribution in any given year, an annual call for applications will be made before Semester 1. It remains the discretion of the Trustee's if any further rounds are opened throughout the year.
Duration	1 year – Scholarships could be approved for longer than one year if continuing financial assistance is necessary for the course to be completed. Any such approval will be reviewed annually.
Eligible Costs	 Eligible costs: Secondary school/TAFE Fees (limited to no more than 50% of the maximum scholarship value) Board & accommodation Textbook and course materials Uniforms Travel or relocation costs to/from place of study IT Equipment – laptop/digital media etc. Study tours (domestic) Ineligible costs: University fees (HECS) able to be deferred Mobile phone & charges Alcohol Any debt
Payment Method	Bank account – In most cases, scholarship payments for secondary school students are made to the student's parent or guardian. Payment may be made directly to a provider upon request.
Reporting	At the end of each semester the recipient will be required to provide a report detailing: 1. How the scholarship funds have been spent. 2. An update on academic progress A report template will be provided. It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to provide this report to the Trustees by the specified date.
Applications	Only completed applications accompanied by all supporting documents will be considered. Scholarships are limited in number, and subject to availability. Even if an applicant meets scholarship criteria, a scholarship may not be awarded. All scholarships are awarded on the basis that you will maintain an active enrolment status at a secondary school or full-time enrolment in your approved course of tertiary or vocational education.
